**Readers and Eucharistic Ministers:** There will be a joint meeting for Readers and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion on Monday, 22 September at 7.30 p.m. in Saint Mungo's Retreat. There are no earlier meetings because of the Our Lady of Sorrows Novena.

**R.C.I.A. – Journey of Faith:** The new R.C.I.A. session will begin later this year. The R.C.I.A. group exists to help adults who wish to prepare to be baptised or confirmed or who are interested in becoming Catholics. The group normally meets from the autumn until Pentecost. Meetings are held weekly and last about an hour and a half. The meeting includes a time of prayer, scripture reading, a chance to talk and share our faith together, and instruction on some aspect of the Catholic faith. **Saint Charles Healing Mass:** At the 12.15 Mass every Saturday, there are Novena Prayers in honour of Saint Charles of Mount Argus, followed by Blessing with the Relic of Saint Charles. The 12.15 Mass on Saturdays is offered for those who are enrolled in the Passionist Mass Guild.

**Doors Open Day:** On 20 and 21 September, the City of Glasgow celebrates "Doors Open Day", when historic buildings are opened to the public. To mark "Doors Open Day", the church will remain open on the Saturday afternoon (20 September).

**Una Voce Mass:** There will be a Latin Mass in the old rite (which is now more correctly called the *Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite*) in Saint Mungo's on Saturday, 20 September at 10.45 a.m. The Mass, which is for the A.G.M. of *Una Voce*, will be followed by a lecture in the Middle Hall by Alcuin Reid.

**The Mass Bus:** The Bus which brings parishioners from Sighthill to 12.00 noon Sunday Mass leaves Saint Stephen's Primary School every Sunday at 11.40 a.m. The bus also stops in Fountainwell Road.
