'Do this in memory'

Have you ever thought about what it means to be called the Body of Jesus?

So often, people forget what is central to our faith, the Eucharist – the Body and Blood of Jesus.

This feast reminds us that we are called not only to receive Jesus in the Eucharist, but also to be part of His body here on earth. And, if we are part of His body, we should always do what is right and for the good of the community. But what can we do? As individuals, we can often fail to achieve what we set out to do. But as a group of believers, with God in our hearts, we can achieve what we set out to do, and bring the good news of God's love to everyone we meet as God has asked us to do. Who did I speak to today about Jesus? Have I spoken in prayer to God? Do I respect those around me and receive respect back? Do I take time to spend in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament? If the answer to the answer to these questions is Yes, then you are doing well. If however, the answer is No, then we shall have to consider how we can resurrect the enthusiasm and let the world know how happy we can be.
