In the gospel today, we hear that Jesus went to his home town with his disciples. The people in the town know Jesus so well since he grew up there and they knew his parents and all his relatives. But the surprising thing for the people of the town was what they heard Jesus speak about in the synagogue. Here was the carpenter's son, yet he spoke with authority and a confidence that they did not expect. This caused them confusion and they found it difficult to accept what Jesus said as the word of God. I wonder? Has this ever happened to any of us gathered here today? Have we become so used to listening to Jesus that we fail to really hear the message he brings? Perhaps the message that we hear today is that we need to take time to really listen to the Lord and understand what God wants each of us to do with our lives. Then when we recognise Jesus among us, we will be able to avoid the confusion that they people of his village experienced as we go out and proclaim the Good News.
