Today, we hear Jesus speak to his disciples as he sends them out to minister to the people. He tells them to take nothing with them except a staff. Can you imagine this, no spare clothes, or extra food. No money or even extra shoes.

How different it is for us when we go on a journey, we take many things, and sometimes we even take things that we do not really need. How many of us can say yes to that?

But when Jesus speaks of taking nothing, I think he is telling his friends that there is no need to do more than simply share the Word of God with the people they will meet. Everything else will follow. People who listen and accept the word of God will find that they have everything they really need, and not simply what they want. So today, we have a choice to make. Do we choose things, or do we choose God as we continue our journey of faith with the Lord Jesus.
