What will I be doing?


As a Women's Beauty Therapist Volunteer, you will be enabling our clients to express themselves through make-up and build their confidence.

- Applying make-up and/or skincare products and/or nail art.
- Teaching and empowering the clients to do some of this themselves.
- Planning for the sessions ahead with your volunteer supervisor and agreeing together on supplies and expenses.
- Engaging with clients inclusively, empathetically and respectfully.
- Adhering to St Mungo's Policies and Procedures at all times.

- Have the necessary experience, Makeup Artist Qualification and Insurance; and/or have the necessary experience, Nail Technician Qualification and Insurance.

- A friendly personality, good interpersonal skills, enthusiasm and motivation.
- An understanding of the causes of homelessness and its impact.
