

Women's Beauty Therapist Volunteer

What will I be doing?

As a Women's Beauty Therapist Volunteer you will be offering makeovers and/or manicures as well as some guidance for self-makeovers. This activity would enable our clients to express themselves through make-up and build confidence. Tasks you would be carrying out include:

- Working in a women's service to apply make-up and/or nail art as well as teaching and empowering the clients to do some of this themselves.
- When applying makeup or nail art, being warm, friendly and empathetic to clients' needs.
- Working with clients inclusively, empathetically and respectfully.
- Adhering to St Mungo's Policies and Procedures at all times.
- Promoting St Mungo's work in an appropriate manner.
- Actively promoting equality, diversity and inclusion among staff, fellow volunteers and clients.

Do I need to have specific skills?

- Have the necessary experience, Makeup Artist Qualification and Insurance; and/or have the necessary experience, Nail Technician Qualification and Insurance.
- Female or female identifying applicants only.
- Client and customer focused. Ability to see the best in people and to motivate individuals.
- Experience or understanding of working with a range of people, as we have residents from different backgrounds and cultures. An understanding of and commitment to diversity & equality.
- The capacity to bring to the sessions some materials and equipment; e.g. your preferred makeup and/or nail products; we can provide some monetary expenses for supplies, but this will need to be agreed between you and the service.
- Willingness to attend training to develop you in your volunteer role.
- Must be reliable and committed.
- Have good communication skills with a friendly and calm manner. A friendly personality, good interpersonal skills, enthusiasm and motivation.
- An understanding of the causes of homelessness and its impact. A genuine interest in and commitment to St Mungo's work and client group.

We particularly welcome applicants with experience of using and moving on from support services.
